- **Labels** **Each container must have a HI 5¢ label. If the label has fallen off, it can be placed inside the container.**
- **Clean** Containers must be emptied of contents and debris.
- **Sorted** The transaction moves quickly if your HI-5 containers are already sorted when you arrive. Please separate by type: cans, glass, plastic, bi-metal.
- **Caps** The State of Hawai'i requires that all caps be removed. You may put caps in a zip lock bag and bring them in for school art projects.
